

2020 Bills Supported by Anthropocene Now Praxis Lab

HB 235 - Voluntary Home Energy Information Pilot Program

- Provides homebuyers a "home energy performance report" to provide education about the estimated annual energy costs and emissions of the home.
- Signed into law.

HB 259 - Electric Vehicle Charging Network

- Works with the Utah Department of Transportation to develop a plan for a statewide network of fast charging stations for electric vehicles.
- Signed into law.

HCR 11 - Concurrent Resolution Supporting the Utah Roadmap for Positive Solutions and Leadership on Climate and Air Quality

- Supports the recommendations of the Technical Advisory Team; and encourages individuals, corporations, and state entities to reduce emissions, using the Utah Roadmap as a guide.
- Not heard in the House Rules Committee.

SCR 12 - Concurrent Resolution Concerning Climate Action

- Supports the recommendations of the Technical Advisory Team; and encourages individuals, corporations, and state entities to reduce emissions, using the Utah Roadmap as a guide.
- Not heard in the House Rules Committee.

HB 194 - Clean and Renewable Energy Requirement Amendments

- Creates a standard for utilities to reach 50% of generation from solar wind, hydro, geothermal, and nuclear.
- Got to the House Public Utilities Committee. Was not heard.

HB 176 - Vehicle Emissions Reduction Program

- Takes the dirtiest cars off the road by incentivizing replacement of older, failing vehicles with cleaner vehicles.
- Not heard in the House Rules Committee.
