Job Description for Volunteers

Overview

Ute Weather Center volunteers will work directly with Ute Weather Center staff, learning the daily operations of the UWC, including one or more of the following:

- Weather Forecasting
- Computer Programming
- Broadcast Meteorology

After completing all requirements, volunteers will be regularly scheduled to help produce the Ute Weather Center's daily products, and may participate in operational forecasting.

Hours per week will be scheduled based on availability and preference.

Requirements

- 1. Attend forecast discussions for at least one week
- 2. Schedule shadowing shifts with a forecaster in the office
- 3. After a week of shadowing, begin individual practice forecasts for Ogden
- 4. Complete Phase I of internal training program within the first 60 days of first shadow shift.

Qualifications

• Must adhere to the Ute Weather Center Standard Operating Procedures
